Sabuli Sanguma DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO

Sabuli is a leader in the Covenant Church of Congo. During the most recent civil war (1997-2003), she and her five children were separated from her husband who was in the U.S. attending seminary. They hid in the jungle for three months and eventually were reunited within the U.S. Overwhelmed by the number of orphans following the war, she began providing foster care and soon opened Sabuli's Place, now home to 85 children. Sabuli is a courageous and outspoken leader who is making an extraordinary impact in the lives of women and children. She is the wife of Dr. Mossai Sanguma, previous president of the CEUM they have six children.



Sunita Keskar INDIA

Sunita has served in ministry with the Hindustani Covenant Church (HCC) for 20 years. She meets with women in rural areas for counseling and encouragement, and ministers with low caste women in animal husbandry projects. The cows and goats provide crucial income nutrition, and each first-born offspring is returned to HCC to be given to another beneficiary family. The animal husbandry project also has a woman-run dairy cooperative that benefits many families. Sunita and her husband Mohanish have two daughters.



Eréndida Leyva MEXICO CITY, MEXICO

Eréndida is a leader of the Evangelical Covenant Church in Nicolás Romero, Mexico. With her husband Miguel, she leads the youth group, and advises the district level youth ministry. Eréndida connects through vacation Bible school and plans weekly worship, leads rehearsals, and has arranged music lessons for young people so they can participate in worship. She is passionate to see women grow in their faith and coordinates her church's women ministries, leading Bible studies and events. She is a safe and compassionate informal counselor. She and her husband have two sons.

Ada Jakeline Rios Garcia OAXACA, MEXICO

Ada has served the Lord for over 20 years, working with children, adolescents, and adults in Oaxaca, Mexico. She currently focuses on Women Ministries, leading Bible studies, workshops, and discipleship. Ada is training to be a facilitator in MAEM, a Covenant ministry with abused and exploited women, and seeks to grow every day, receiving God's restoration and health. Ada and her husband have a daughter and a son.



Kinko Hyoshi JAPAN

Kinko is pastor of the Nagaoka Covenant Church with her husband, Rev. Makoto Hiyoshi, working in youth ministry, cell groups, worship, and evangelism. Kinko attended college in Osaka, and after meeting the Lord, she took seminary classes and met her husband. In 1994 they moved to Nagaoka to serve their current church. In 2004 the Chuetsu Earthquake struck, causing serious damage to their building. With the help of churches in Taiwan, the US and Japan, the building was renovated. The experience of loss of shelter and basic amenities deepened her heart of compassion. The couple has four children.



Marisete Martinsson SWEDEN

Sweden has welcomed the most war refugees per capita of any country in the European Union, and Marisete has worked to provide food, clothing, and to pray for, and help the war ravaged people in her village.
